'Fetal Cardiac Anomalies Review'

Topics covered include:

Day 1: Delivering bad news, cardiac counselling for cardiac anomalies. Assessment of fetal circulation and cardiac position, atrial-ventricular-atrioventricular septal defects, chromosome anomalies and heart defects, hypoplastic left heart, heart rhythm abnormalities, mitral and tricuspid inflow abnormalities, cardiac masses, pericardial effusion, nuchal translucency, plenty of case demonstrations.

Day 2: Use of Doppler and colour in diagnosing aortic and pulmonary artery anomalies, transposition of great arteries, tetralogy of Fallot, truncus arteriosus, coarction of aorta, three vessel view and cardiac anomalies, fetal cardiac function and cardiomyopathies, fetal venous and arterial Doppler and plenty of case demonstrations.
