

Cleaning and disinfection program MR



Note: Before cleaning and disinfecting the equipment, please read the "Cleaning and Disinfection" section of the Philips "Instruction for Use" carefully to ensure safety and operability.

Cleaning program

MR

1. Use a soft cloth dipped in neutral *soap or*

- detergent (recommended to use liquid soap instead of disinfectant), wipe the surface of the equipment until the visible contaminants on the surface are removed.
- 2. Use a *soft cloth dipped in clean water* to remove the remaining particles and residues.
- **3.** Use a *dry soft cloth* to dry the surface of the equipment.
- **4.** For positioning straps, it is recommended to clean using a *neutral soap or detergent* (can be machine washed at **40 °C/104 °F** or lower) and use after drying.
- **5.** When cleaning the digital coil plug, please use alcohol, soft cloth and cotton swabs provided with the system.
- 6 Used cleaning materials should be disposed according to pollutant disposal regulations.
- 7 If mats, sandbags or earphone sponge pads are found damaged, please replace them immediately and do not continue to use.

 5. Never use flammable or explosion-prone disinfectant sprays. The steam may cause fire, fatal injury or other serious personal

 6. It is not recommended to spray disinfect the medical equipment room, because the
- vapor may enter the equipment, causing short circuit or corrosion.

 7. Used cleaning materials should be disposed
- 8. If mats, sandbags or earphone sponge pads are found damaged, please replace them immediately and do not continue to use.
- **9.** If cracks or damage are found on coils or cables, do not continue to use.
